

The Supreme Court's rulings in three cases can be summarized as follows: in electioneering: money=speech and corporations are people.

- Citizens United v FEC (2010) overturned a 1907 federal statue that prohibited corporations from spending money to influence elections.
- Speech Now v FEC (2010) expanded Citizens United to allow PACs to accept corporate money for "independent" campaign expenditures giving rise to superPACs

Over 16 states and 500 municipalities have passed resolutions calling on Congress to propose a constitutional amendment to make it clear that money # speech and corporations are not people

• McCutcheon v FEC (2014) overturned the federal <u>aggregate</u> limits on donations to candidates and party committees.
